What a weekend it has been...There was a ceasefire and 3 hostages were returned safely, Martin Luther King, Jr. observance, the inauguration of our 47th President, and our drive to SUNY Oneonta. Our emotions were all over the place. During morning minyan on Sunday, our Rabbi informed us that the three hostage women were safe in Israel. She was crying, the person reading a Prayer for Israel has a granddaughter in the IDF, he could not make it past the second sentence and the next person was overcome with

emotion. This was just the beginning of how we all felt. Let's pray that this continues and that all of the hostages continue to return safely. Then Monday, after leaving late because of the snow storm, we were taking my daughter back to college for her very last semester and I streamed the inauguration as we drove. I was filled with very mixed emotions and can only hope that everything works out ok. I was exhausted by the time we got home at 10 pm as it was a little longer drive to avoid the roads that we took up there as we thought they would be bad at night.

Let us pray for both Israel and the United States.





There are the families you are born into and the families you choose. Suburbia—the quintessential quagmire of coexistence in which strangers of varied ethnicities and financial statuses meet at the local gas station, supermarket, and café and speak in snippets of feigned and genuine cordiality. People with whom we rarely envision sharing anything more of ourselves ... until we do.

Seventeen years after losing the love of her life on 9/11, Lila, a nurse aide, and her teenage son Dante, find solace in unlikely companions— a group of Mahjong-playing octogenarians. There's Lila's client, Thea, struggling with Alzheimer's, and her sweet husband, Joseph; Mali, a lonely Holocaust survivor living far away from her only daughter; childless and recently widowed Frank; and the persnickety, divorced Gladys, whom Mali disliked from the moment the two met. When Brian, a duplicitous new neighbor, and Dante's friends Rashon and Giselle, join the mix, all their lives take surprising turns that raise questions about the concepts of family, loyalty, and love.


