#### Note from Tova Rothschild, GSR Social Action Chair

Jewish philosophy emphasizes Tzedakah, the obligation to donate to the poor and needy, as a fundamental aspect of ethical living and a means of bringing social justice. This isn't seen as a charitable act but as a religious duty and a way to fulfill the covenant with God. Tzedakah is derived from the Hebrew word for "righteousness" and "justice," highlighting its core moral imperative. It's not just a matter of giving generously, but of ensuring that the needy receive what they are due. Donations are seen as a way to address social inequality and promote a more just society. Judaism emphasizes the inherent dignity of all individuals, regardless of their financial status. Judaism also teaches that donors benefit from tzedakah as much as or more than the poor recipients themselves, and this belief remains a common theme in Jewish tradition. Whereas the poor receive donations of material assistance or money, the donor receives the merit of sharing God's work.

In the spirit of social justice please consider bringing non-perishable kosher food items and/or feminine hygiene products to the Women of Achievement Gala on June 9, 2025.

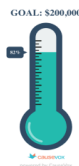

# Prayer for the Return of Slain Hostages

(in English & Hebrew)

☆ **Prayer for the Return of Slain Hostages** ☆

*Barokh atah Adonai, sovereign of time and space, the Judge of truth.*

*Arise Malkinu, hear our voice, be kind and have compassion for us, willingly and lovingly accept our prayer.*

*Arise Malkinu, do this for the sake of those who were martyred for Your holy name and for the sake of those who were slaughtered for their exclusive devotion to You.*

*Arise Malkinu, do not turn us away empty-handed, and have compassion for us, our infants and our children.*

May it be Your will, *Adonai* our God and God of our ancestors, watch over, safeguard, strengthen and embrace and comfort the families of the slain hostages who were kidnapped and murdered by ruthless enemies and returned for eternal rest in Your holy land after 503 days.

The One who heals the broken-hearted and binds their wounds, encircle their loved ones with Your kindness, alleviate their suffering, dress their wounds and grant them and us comfort and healing for our agonizing bodies and crying souls.

There is no greater mitzvah than the redemption of captives. Master of mercy, ensure that the rest of our brothers and sisters return swiftly from captivity, those in joy to life and rehabilitation, and those in sadness – to eternal rest.

And may it be fulfilled that 'the sons [and daughters] come back to their place.' And let us say: Amen.
