For me, it started this past Wednesday at our Region Board meeting with my delivery of the d'var torah for Selichot Ki Tavo, 9/11 occurring the next day, and further contemplating this month of the High Holy Days. Ki Tavo focuses on gratitude, remembrance, and the consequences of our actions and Hope/Renewal. All of the emotions that take us through this period of the Jewish calendar.

I count myself very lucky to be here as a 9/11 survivor and hug my family extra tight during this time. I know that there are many others that are not so lucky. I also get to celebrate my daughter, who was born 2 years 2 days later. She is my bright star that came out of a dark time. With all this self reflection and notes of bettering myself I cannot help to think about the hostages still not with their families after more than 700 days. Please get them home to their loved ones.

Please remember that the Garden State Region Board members and I are here to support and answer all of your questions and offer guidance. I look forward to hearing and going to your programs. 
