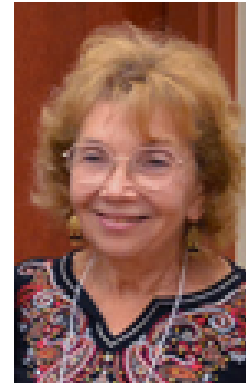

Many will be seeking scholarships, so you are required to seek other available stipends before applying. For example, some Sisterhoods will provide stipends to its members attending WLCJ Convention. In some cases, synagogues may have funds available such as the Rabbi's Discretionary Fund. In the scholarship application, you will be asked about your efforts to secure other stipends.
